Providence, R.I. (May 19, 2023) — The Department of Children, Youth & Families (DCYF) is disclosing the fatality of a nine-year-old child. The Department was open to the family at the time of the incident. However, DCYF did not have custody of the child at the time of the death.

The fatality occurred on May 18, 2023. The Department has initiated an investigation into this fatality. DCYF has notified the Office of the Child Advocate of this report.

Due to confidentiality laws, DCYF is prohibited from sharing additional information.

DCYF's highest priority is the safety and well-being of all children. Rhode Islanders are required by law to report known or suspected cases of child abuse or neglect to DCYF within 24 hours of becoming aware of such abuse/neglect.
