Providence, R.I. (June 27, 2023) — The Department of Children, Youth & Families (DCYF) is disclosing the near fatality of a nine-month-old child. The Department had prior involvement with the family but was not open to the family at the time of the incident.

The incident occurred on June 13, 2023. DCYF initiated an investigation into this case and confirmed today that maltreatment contributed to this near fatality. Pursuant to state law, DCYF has notified the Office of the Child Advocate of the report.

Due to confidentiality laws, DCYF is prohibited from sharing additional information.

DCYF's highest priority is the safety and well-being of all children. Rhode Islanders are required by law to report known or suspected cases of child abuse or neglect to DCYF within 24 hours of becoming aware of such abuse/neglect.
