Providence, R.I. (April 26, 2024) – Pursuant to the Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA) as amended 42 U.S.C. § 106 (b)(4)(A), the Department of Children, Youth & Families (DCYF) is disclosing the near fatality of a 16-month-old child. DCYF did not have prior involvement with the family.

The incident occurred on April 11, 2024, with a final finding determination made on April 26, 2024. DCYF has notified the Office of the Child Advocate.

Due to confidentiality laws, DCYF is prohibited from sharing additional information.

DCYF's highest priority is the safety and well-being of all children. Rhode Islanders are required by law to report known or suspected cases of child abuse or neglect to DCYF within 24 hours of becoming aware of such abuse/neglect.
